### **Next Steps**

The graduate coordinator is currently revising the CIED Ph.D. handbook to update the department's expectations for the Qualifying Exam, Dissertation format, and Dissertation expectations. This revision also includes consideration for a 3 Article Dissertation format. A committee made up of Graduate Faculty was formed to collect materials from universities around the country to ascertain their expectations regarding 3 article Dissertations. Best practices were also collected regarding the Qualifying Exam and traditional dissertations. These will be synthesized, along with CIED faculty input, to comprise an updated set of departmental expectations in 2019-2020.
