Assessment of Doctoral Student Learning

Direct Methods

- 1. Comprehensive examinations: Eight current Ed. D. students have passed the written and oral comprehensive examination this academic year.
- 2. Successful Dissertation Defense: Four doctoral students successfully defended their dissertations this academic year.
- 3. Successful Proposal Defense: Three additional doctoral students successfully defended their dissertation proposals this academic year.

Indirect Methods

- 1. Course grades and written or oral assignment results: not reported by faculty.
- 2. Student feedback on course evaluations: not reported by faculty.

Program Assessment Supportive to Student Learning Outcomes

Results

- 1. Three new doctoral students were added to the HRWD program in Summer/Fall 2018 and one new student was admitted for Spring 2019. There are a total of 37 students currently in the program (one student dropped for personal reasons but plans to return). Seven new doctoral applicants have already been admitted for the summer and fall 2019 semesters.
- 2. Another survey will be initiated, with possible assistance of the UA Alumni Association, about effectiveness of our HRD graduate programs for those who graduated during the last five years. Results from a prior survey through the UA Alumni Association yielded limited results.
