

B.S.E. in Educational Studies 2017-2018

Based on the submitted program assessment plan for Educational Studies, three of three student learning outcomes have been able to be assessed.

- 32 students completed the capstone course.
 - Capstone assessments portfolio for the 32 participants were awarded the following ranks: 32 – passed
- 11 students graduated for Summer 2017. 6 students graduated in Fall 2017. 10 graduated in Spring 2018. These 5 students had been participants in Educational Studies since the programs initialization in Aug 2014; 18 students joined the program in 2015; 9 students joined the program in 2016.
 - EDST program graduation rate for expected graduates: 100%
 - EDST program graduation for 4 year enrollment: N/A (available 2018)
 - EDST program graduation for 5 year enrollment: N/A (available 2019)
- 21 of 27 EDST program graduates (78%) had confirmed post-graduate plans prior to graduation. (Employment or graduate school; some categories may overlap)
 - 5 students took full-time jobs with non-profit education agencies.
 - 5 students took full-time jobs in the public education sector.
 - 6 students took full-time jobs in the private education sector.
 - 2 students were accepted into an alternative licensure program.
 - Oklahoma – 1; Texas – 1
 - 4 students were accepted to graduate programs prior to graduation.
 - (M.Ed x 1.; M.A.T. x 3)
 - 4 students accepted non-education/private-sector positions
 - 6 students (22%) did not respond to the inquiry.
