Assessment of Doctoral Student Learning

Direct Methods

1. Comprehensive examinations: Four current Ed. D. students have passed the written and oral comprehensive examination this academic year.
2. Successful Dissertation Defense: Three doctoral students successfully defended their dissertations this academic year.

Indirect Methods

1. Course grades and written or oral assignment results: see above.
2. Student feedback on course evaluations: not reported by faculty.
3. Dissertation Committee feedback not reported by faculty.

Program Assessment Supportive to Student Learning Outcomes

Results

1. Five new doctoral applicants were added to the HRWD program in Summer/Fall 2019 and three new applicants were admitted for Spring 2020. There are a total of 24 students currently in the program. Five new doctoral applicants have already been admitted for the summer and fall 2020 semesters.
2. Another survey will be initiated, with possible assistance of the UA Alumni Association, about effectiveness of our HRD graduate programs for those who graduated during the last five years. Results from a prior survey through the UA Alumni Association yielded limited results.
3. The HRWD program underwent a full program review during Fall 2017.
4. Two new graduate faculty members started Fall 2019.
