Summary of Findings for AY 2021-2022

BSW STUDENTS:

Learning Contract: All 3 cohorts of the BSW students (Fall 2019, Spring 2020 and Summer 2020) met the benchmarks set for all 9 competencies and all 31 practice behaviors.

Survey: All 3 cohorts of the BSW students (Fall 2019, Spring 2020 and Summer 2020) met the benchmarks set for 7 of the competencies and for 26 of the 31 practice behaviors.

Competencies that did not meet the benchmark of 70% are: #2 (Engage in diversity & difference in practice) and #9 (Evaluate practice with individuals, families, groups, organizations & communities)

Practice behaviors that did not meet the benchmark of 70% are: #2.1, # 5.1, #9.1, #9.2 and #9.3

FOUNDATION MSW STUDENTS:

Learning Contract: All MSW Foundation students met the benchmarks set for all 9 competencies and all 31 practice behaviors.

Survey: The MSW Foundation students met the benchmarks set for 6 of the competencies and for 18 of the 31 practice behaviors.

Competencies that did not meet the benchmark of 70% are: #2 (Engage in diversity & difference in practice), #5 (Engage in policy practice) and #9 (Evaluate practice with individuals, families, groups, organizations & communities)

Practice behaviors that did not meet the benchmark of 70% are: #1.1, 1.3, #1.5, #2.1, #3.1, #4.2, # 5.1, #6.1, #7.1, #8.1 #9.1, #9.2 and #9.3

ONLINE CONCENTRATION MSW STUDENTS:

Learning Contract: Data not entered correctly and therefore not able to analyze.

Survey: The Online MSW Concentration students met the benchmarks set for 7 of the competencies and for 18 of the 23 practice behaviors.

Competencies that did not meet the benchmark of 70% are: #3 (Advance human rights and social, economic & environmental justice), and #9 (Evaluate practice with individuals, families, groups, organizations & communities)

Practice behaviors that did not meet the benchmark of 70% are: #3.1, #5.1, #8.1, #9.2 and #9.4

FACE-TO-FACE CONCENTRATION MSW STUDENTS:

Learning Contract: Data not entered correctly and therefore not able to analyze.

Survey: The Face-To-Face MSW Concentration students met the benchmarks set for 6 of the competencies and for 15 of the 23 practice behaviors.

Competencies that did not meet the benchmark of 70% are: #3 (Advance human rights and social, economic & environmental justice), #6 (Engage with individuals, families, groups, organizations & communities) and #9 (Evaluate practice with individuals, families, groups, organizations & communities)

Practice behaviors that did not meet the benchmark of 70% are: #1.1, #3.1, #3.2, #5.1, #6.2 #8.1, #9.1, #9.2 and #9.4

Tasks to be Completed for AY 2021-2022:

- 1. Present findings at Fall 2021 School of Social Work Retreat and lead discussion on implications for programmatic modifications.**
2. Send out email reminders to Associate Clinical Professor about 3 weeks prior to the end of each semester, with the correct survey link (there should be a different link for BSW, Foundation MSW and Concentration MSW cohorts), to collected data during seminar classes.
3. Determine which Competencies and Practice Behaviors from the MSW Concentration Survey match with each question on the survey. **This needs to be completed BEFORE administering the MSW Concentration Survey during the Spring 2022 semester.**
4. Recode and analyze BSW, Foundation MSW and Concentration MSW cohort data.
5. Recode and analyze BSW, Foundation MSW and Concentration MSW Field Learning Contract cohort data.
6. Recode and analyzed BSW, Foundation MSW and Concentration MSW Survey cohort data.
7. Write reports with findings for each cohort.
8. Send reports to HEI coordinator to post on SCWK website for CSWE.
